"For I hear many whispering: "Terror is all around! Denounce him! Let us denounce him!" All my close friends are watching for me to stumble.


"Perhaps he can be enticed, and we can prevail against him, and take our revenge on him." "But the LORD is with me like a dread warrior;

Romans 6:1b-11

Should we continue in sin in order that grace may abound? ⁸By no means! How can we who died to sin go on living in it? ⁹Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴Therefore we have been buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. ³For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. ⁸We know

that our old self was crucified with him so that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be destroyed, and we might no longer be enslaved to sin. "For whoever has died is freed from sin. "But if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.
